A. CALL TO ORDER

The Public Input Meeting for the new St. Helena Branch Library was called to order by Trevor Collings at 5:06 p.m. Audubon Regional Library Board Member Faye H. Talbot was present. There were twelve members of the public in attendance.

B. RECEIVE PUBLIC INPUT AND COMMENTS ON PROPOSED GREENSBURG BRANCH LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION AND DESIGN.

Trevor Collings welcomed the public to the meeting and introduced Paul Theriot, Jr., the design architect from Holly and Smith Architects.

Paul presented the design for the new library to the public using graphics and project drawings. Paul describing the location, parking lot, building design characteristics, enhancements, and types of construction materials for the structure. Then, Trevor Collings and Paul Theriot answered questions and discussed the various suggestions provided by the public. Some suggestions from the public were as follows:

Consider a location for snack/drink vending machines, provide a small refrigerator in the public meeting room, verify that the book drop is fire/vandal resistant, interior color choices and consider efficient patron circulation path from children's area to outside fenced courtyard when placement of book stacks and furniture.

Trevor Collings thanked the members of the public for their attendance and input on the new St. Helena branch Library.
